


# HSA MEETING MINUTES

2-4-09



Hello HSA Members,

Thank you to all those who were able to make it to our meeting on 2/4. We had a GREAT turn out, and I hope you continue to be active members and participate in our various events throughout the semester. Here is what was discussed at the meeting:

- (1) **HSA Scholarship:** Katie Rusak, Director of Development for Honors and Scholarships, spoke to us about creating an HSA Scholarship, that could be rewarded as early as May 2009! Your role as an HSA member would be to make sure that you had active status (5 points) for the semester, as this would be the only way to apply for the scholarship. *Only HSA members would be eligible to apply for this scholarship.* Still in the planning stages, the scholarship would be an annual scholarship, rewarding a certain amount. *More details to follow as we begin developing this scholarship.*
- (2) **Grad Expo Fair:** Christina Safar spoke to us about volunteering at the Grad expo fair. It will be April 15-17 at the Welcome Center. Students will receive a free WSU Alumni sweatshirt for helping out. Complete the attached application form and turn in to the front desk of the Honors office.
- (3) **Health fair:** Spring Health Fair. Wednesday, April 8 from 11am to 3pm at the Fountain court in front of the UGL. We will have multiple stations, with 2-3 students per station. We are also planning on having med school/DMC doctors at stations with the students. We will discuss what sort of stations students want to do, but some examples include blood pressure station, BMI station, station about the importance of fiber, etc. etc. Students can bring up ideas about what sort of station they would like to be at.
